Nasiha of the Month

May this newsletter find everyone in the best of health, iman, and closeness to God, Almighty.

As we are over a month away from the blessed month of Ramadan, we should start reflecting on how to get ourselves ready to capture and attain all of the blessings, light, and spiritual awakenings that occurs in the month. This is the month of Rajab, which the Prophet Muhammad, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, when he entered it, he would say, "O Allah bless us in our Rajab and Sha`ban and cause us to reach Ramadan!" In a hadith



in the collection of Imam Nasa'i that is graded Hasan, Usamah ibn Zaid reported: I said, "O Messenger of Allah, I do not see you fasting any month as much as you fast during Sha'ban." The Prophet, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, said, "It is a month people neglect between the months of Rajab and Ramadan. It is a month in which the deeds are raised to the Lord of the worlds and I like for my deeds to be raised while I am fasting."

We see in this hadith the importance of the month of Sha'ban as well. Our deeds ascend to our Lord so the Prophet, may Allah bless him and grant him peace, used to fast so that they go to Him, while in worship.

May Allah grant us the blessing of entering in to Ramadan.

"Whoever wakes up at night and says: 'None has the right to be worshipped except Allah, alone and with no partner, to Him belongs [all] sovereignty and praise, and He is able to do all things; How far from imperfections Allah is, and all praise is for Allah, and none has the right to be worshipped except Allah, Allah is the greatest, and there is no power nor might except with Allah, The Most High, The Supreme.' and then supplicates: 'O my Lord forgive me. ' will be forgiven, and then asks [for something], he will be answered. If he then performs ablution and prays, his prayer will be accepted." - Bukhari

Shaykh Nuh Keller is a American convert, who studied at the University of Chicago and UCLA. He entered Islam in 1977 in Cairo. He has been studying the Sciences of the Din and Islamic law including Hadith, Tafsir, Fiqh, Aqida, and Spirituality since 1980 when he moved to Amman, Jordan, to the present. He is authorized to teach all



of the Islamic Sciences including Islamic Spirituality. His translation of the Umdat al-Salik, (Reliance of the Traveler) is the first Islamic legal work in a European language to receive the certification of al-Azhar, the Muslim world's oldest institution of higher learning. He has lectured around the world, and at leading universities, including Harvard.

He is here to teach classes in Spirituality, from the books of the great scholars of the past.
